

Installing the bed rail



- (1) Slide the base of the bed rail between the mattress and the base of the bed.
- (2) Position the handle to the most convenient location for your client. Usually about 600 mm down from the head end of the bed.



- (3) Braided cord: Extend the braided cord to the other side of the bed, pull the cord tight through the block and secure the cord in the plastic cleat.
- (4) Strap and buckle: Extend the strap between the mattress and the bed base to the other side of the bed. Secure the end of the strap around the bed leg and tighten the strap

Trial equipment
