
## Lazy Boy Chair Raiser MF 1/3



(1) Perimeter lip (2) Bracket Clamp (3) Spreader board (4) Knobs (5) Wing nuts (6) Splayed feet

For Lazy Boy Chairs that rock or recline, this Raiser is a perfect solution.

Splayed feet give extra stability to chairs with a narrow base like this one. Two strong bracket clamps resist the chair jumping off the Raiser as the user rocks back and forth.

- Chair stays in place 20mm perimeter lip holds the Raiser to the chair.
- Rocking the chair is safe rear clamps hold the chair down into the Raiser.
- Easy to fit Telescopic adjustment ensures you get the perfect fit easily
- Tested Independently tested to ensure your safety.
- **Unique clamping action** holds the Raiser tightly to a fixed size. (Fig 4)
- Extra stability is provided with Splayed feet
- Re Issuable Robust construction enables the Raiser to be re issued.





# Lazy Boy Chair Raiser MF 1/3 Fitting Instructions

The following method ensures the Raiser is fitted correctly, safely and with the minimum of effort.








(1) Roll the chair forward so the feet of the chair are accessible.

(2) Adjust the Raiser in width and length so the lip of the Raiser fits snugly over the base of the chair.


(3) Tighten the knobs & wing nuts on all four telescopic sides of the Raiser.

Place the spreader board (4) under the bracket clamps (5)

Turn the wing nut (6) so it tightens down onto spreader board (7). Tighten the second wing nut (8).

(9) Roll the Chair Raiser back onto its base & push the raised Chair back into its original location. Note the chair base fits 20mm down inside the raiser perimeter (10)

Assessment notes: Was the chair raised to the correct height? Does the user look more confident? Chairs are most stable when getting in and out. Reaching over the side of the chair is not recommended. If over time the situation changes and the user needs additional assistance, consider Chair Transfer Rails or an orthopaedic chair.

Maintenance - check tightness of the raiser to the chair, tightness of wing nuts, knobs and fixings.

Cleaning - with damp cloth. use non-abrasive detergent and dry thoroughly.

Checks: Confirm the raised chair is safe and stable. When getting out of the chair your feet

are flat on the floor and your bottom approximately level with the underside of your knees. Is getting in and out of the chair easier? Is the comfort acceptable?





The picture above shows a cross section through the chair. Note that the base of the chair (11) fits within the perimeter lip (12) of the Chair Raiser
